

Lewelling NDA Meeting Minutes 3-3-05

Measure 3-166

City Manager Mike Swanson spoke of annexing the Clackamas Fire Department 1, and reduce our share of the tax. He explained effectively the wash in the conversion, and the tax is neutral. If this measure is approved we will see a permanent rate with a 0% increase unless it is brought back as a levy.

Capt. Bill Conway, of the Milw. Station, passed out a power point flyer about the measure, and what it means to Milw. Everyone may be seeing them in our neighborhood.

To wrap up the lengthy presentation, Mike Swanson said the Library, police, Code Enforcement, and Fire services will not be going anywhere.

North Clackamas Park Sports Field

Mr. Charlie Ciecko presented a map of the proposed sports field complete with trails, parking detail, and more. Proposed cost is 2.2 million. The changes in the plan have been made to accommodate youth activities. Parking will increase by 233 spaces, and 80% of the increased traffic flow should come straight off of the highway. PA systems have not been added to the plan due to residential concern over the noise pollution.

Land use application will be submitted this spring to the City of Milwaukie, DAB has requested that they move ahead with design and engineering of the proposal.

Code Enforcement

Les and Tim reiterated the importance of calling and reporting violations, or suspected violations, and they will investigate. There is always the option of calling anonymously too. New Mediation workshop is available through the county, and it is highly recommended, and helpful.

Small Park Committee

Lewelling NDA has agreed to have a small committee for the Lewelling community park to expedite problem solving, and not wait for a lot of people to respond to a decision needing immediate attention.
